Airport Authorities Amendment Act 1997

Price Control Study of Airfield Activities

The Minister of Commerce (“the Minister”) has required the Commerce Commission (“the commission”) to report to him by 14 December 1999 on whether price control should be introduced over prices for airfield activities, as defined by the Airport Authorities Amendment Act 1997, at Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch airports.
