Clarification of extension review conference public information

1. This letter clarifies some information we provided at the conference relating to the extent of co-location of our 3G network with our own 2G sites. I would be grateful if you would forward this letter to all conference participants in the usual way.
2. We have co-masted 36% of our lattice tower or pole 3G sites on 2G sites. At the conference, we stated that we co-located 40% and compared this figure with our target of 80%. Subsequent checking has revealed that this historic target actually included all site types, not just lattice towers and poles. Therefore, the comparison with the 40% figure for lattice towers and poles was not relevant.
3. Regarding other site types, we co-mast a further 18% of 3G sites which are either in-building, micro or rooftop sites. We also share facilities on another 22% rooftop 3G sites.
4. Taking all site types into account, we actually co-locate in one way or another 76% of our 3G equipment on our 2G sites, not 40% that we indicated at the conference.
5. We apologise for any confusion caused.
