Mobile Schedule 3 Investigation Conference

Purpose

The purpose of this letter is to outline the draft schedule for the Commission's conference in relation to the Schedule 3 Investigation into whether or not to amend the roaming and co-location services or to accept an undertaking from Vodafone.
