Mobile Investigation

Thank you for updating the Commission on the progress of commercial negotiations with New Zealand Communications (NZC) in relation to roaming and co-location.

The Commission has considered the views expressed by interested parties in submissions and at the conference, and wishes to complete its investigation in relation to mobile roaming and co-location services in a timely manner.

Some of the key issues discussed by parties at the conference that would need to be resolved are:

- A simple predictable structure of appropriate pricing for the roaming service including voice, data and SMS;
- The establishment of targets and key performance indicators for timely co-location;
- Implementation plans for cellular co-location similar to those developed as part of the standard terms determination process for LLU co-location; and
- Timeframes for resolving operational matters and disputes.

In the absence of a concluded commercial agreement or the proffering of an amended undertaking addressing the key concerns discussed at the Commission conference by 2 November, the Commission will proceed to make its final recommendations to the Minister based on the information currently available.
