**Order amending previous Order made by the Commerce Commission
under section 15(i) of the Telecommunications Act 2001 and section 100
of the Commerce Act 1986 and section 9(6) of the Telecommunications Act 2001**

The Commission hereby amends the Order dated 14 May 2003 (the “Order”) made by the Commission under section 15(i) of the Telecommunications Act 2001 (“the Act”) and section 100 of the Commerce Act 1986 and section 9(6) of the Act by inserting a new clause 1A as follows:

“On 2 September 2003, the Commission launched an investigation under clause 1(1) of Schedule 3 to the Act into access to, and interconnection with, the unbundled elements of the telecommunications network of Telecom Corporation of New Zealand Limited (including any of its subsidiaries) under Schedule 3 to the Act.” The wider investigation includes the main distribution frame, ancillary services, co-location, backhaul, line-sharing, bitstream access and access to the PDN. Further details of this investigation are outlined in the Commission’s Gazette notice of 2 September 2003. For the purposes of the Order, and for the avoidance of doubt, the term “Review” (as defined in clause 1 of the Order) includes the investigation launched by the Commission on 2 September 2003 as described in this clause 1A.”
