**Mobile Origination**

I refer to your letter of 30 June 2004 on the status of mobile roaming and mobile origination in terms of the current mobile termination investigation. The Commission has not yet decided on whether there are reasonable grounds to investigate mobile roaming or mobile origination. If the Commission were to consider investigating mobile roaming, that would best be dealt with in a separate investigation as the issues associated with mobile roaming are mostly different to those associated with mobile termination.

The Commission will consider submissions on simultaneously investigating other markets that may be more closely related to mobile termination, such as mobile origination, as indicated by question 4.1(d) in the mobile termination issues paper.

I have attached TelstraClear's recent submission on mobile origination for your information. You may want to include comments on it with your submission on the mobile termination issues paper.

In the interests of transparency, the Commission will post a copy of this letter and the TelstraClear submission on mobile origination on its website.
