**RE: request for additional information after the MTAS Conference**

Thank you for your letter of 7 October 2009<sup>1</sup> regarding Vodafone's provision of additional information relating to a number of matters raised at the MTAS Conference on 2 and 3 September 2009.

In my letter to you of 5 October 2009, the Commission requested that Vodafone resubmit your earlier letter of 1 October 2009 after excluding those portions which are in the nature of a submission, rather than the provision of the information expressly requested by the Commission (as set out in Shane Kinley's email of 15 September 2009).

The Commission notes your proposal that your letter of 1 October 2009 "stand as is, but that the Commission chose to consider or disregard those parts of the letter it considers appropriate" and that the Commission indicate those comments it has disregarded to interested parties to this investigation.

The Commission will consider those parts of your letter of 1 October 2009 which respond directly to the Commission's request for additional information. The Commission will not consider the content of that letter that is in the nature of a submission rather than the provision of the requested information. For example, page 2 in its entirety and the first paragraph on page 3 will not be considered. Other content in the nature of a submission, relating to additional information requests 2, 3 and 4 also will not be considered.

For completeness, I note that the Commission does not intend, at this time, to seek submissions from other parties on any of the information provided in your letter of 1 October 2009.
