**Number Portability Determination –Status of Woosh Wireless Limited (“Woosh”)
as an Access Provider**

We refer to Chris Abbott’s letter of 4 October 2005 (Your reference 2.6/J5803
411912_2.doc).

Woosh considers that it launched a fixed telephone network service in Auckland on 16 September 2005. We have an interconnection agreement with Telecom which acknowledges the nature of the service. Woosh’s services may be accessed via either a POTS phone connected to a voice gateway which in turn is connected to a Woosh modem and or via a PC with a Woosh modem and headset. In either case, the telephone devices are normally located in the end user’s premises. Woosh has allocated each of its customers a local Auckland number and offers all of its customers free local calling. Woosh has not yet launched these services outside of Auckland.

Woosh does not consider that it is currently offering a cellular telephone network service.
