Consultation on Vodafone's Standard Terms Proposal for Mobile Co-location

The Commerce Commission ('**Commission**') has received a Standard Terms Proposal ('**STP**') from Vodafone New Zealand Limited for the specified service described as 'Co-location on cellular mobile transmission sites' in Part 3 of Schedule 1 of the Telecommunications Act 2001 ('**the Mobile Co-location Service**').

You are invited to make a submission on this STP by **5pm on Monday 19 May 2008**. Under section 30J of the Act, your submission:

- may be about any matter to which the proposals relates; but
- must set out the wording of any additional or alternative terms that are proposed to be included in the standard terms determination.
