**Wellington International Airport Limited (WIAL) Cross Submission on the Information Disclosure Discussion Paper**

WIAL has reviewed the Commerce Commission's Information Disclosure Discussion Paper (Discussion Paper), released on 29 July 2009 and the subsequent submissions by Air New Zealand and BARNZ (the airline submissions).

We appreciate the opportunity to submit on the issues set out in the Discussion Paper and subsequent submissions. These issues will have significant implications for WIAL and for the airports generally.

WIAL will not, however, submit a separate cross submission in response to the Discussion Paper and subsequent airline submissions. Instead, to avoid duplicating submissions, we ask the Commission to treat the New Zealand Airports Association submission, to which WIAL is a party, as WIAL's submission also.

Whilst we are not making a separate submission on this occasion, we do so in the expectation of ongoing engagement with the Commission on the information disclosure and input methodology consultation process. In particular, we would be pleased to discuss further with the Commission any issues raised in the New Zealand Airports Association submission that are specific to WIAL.
