**DRAFT RECONSIDERATION REPORT ON WHETHER THE MOBILE

For a number of reasons amply stated over the past 6 years TUANZ is in favour of a decision to recommend regulation of Mobile Termination Access Services (MTAS) and fully endorses and supports the Commerce Commission's Draft Reconsideration Report.

TUANZ remains concerned at the alarming delay to resolution of this matter and would welcome an early meeting with the Commission to discuss both the market implications of such a delay and ways in which to fast-track solutions to resolve this.
