**TelstraClear Bitstream Service  
Request for additional information**

The Commission requests the following information from Telecom in respect of its existing ADSL based services:

1. What business rules apply in respect of spectrum management (i) at the retail level at the point of sale, and (ii) Telecom's internal provisioning of:
  - Jetstream Business 'full-speed'<sup>1</sup> services; and
  - any other data services which include access and utilise the ADSL technology on the local loop (e.g. Secure Business Internet)?
2. Please provide:
  - current subscriber numbers of each Jetstream Business 'full-speed' plan; and
  - monthly subscriber numbers of each Jetstream Business 'full-speed' plan over the last 12 months
3. In its recent submission<sup>2</sup>, Telecom estimates that only a small percentage of lines which could synchronise above 4.048Mbps are within short binders. What is the maximum length of a 'short binder' used in this calculation?

The Commission requests that Telecom provide the information by not later than Monday 26 September 2005.
