

THE INFORMATION REQUEST

We have set out below the information that Chorus, Telecom Wholesale, UCLL Access Seekers, UBA Access Seekers, cable operators and other technology broadband providers (e.g., mobile, wireless) should be able to supply to the Commission as at 30 June 2010.

Chorus

Note 1: Telecom's wholesale contracts prevent Telecom Wholesale from providing the Commission with information on its commercial bitstream services (with the exception of the UBS service) without either written consent from Telecom Wholesale's customers or a regulatory obligation, such as a section 98 notice. Telecom Wholesale's preference is that its customers consent to the disclosure of this information to the Commission. Telecom Wholesale suggests that the Commission ask these customers whether they wish to provide this information to the Commission directly, or whether they consent to Telecom providing it to the Commission on their behalf on a confidential basis.

Note 2: We have recently discovered Telecom Wholesale may have difficulty in providing information on the exact location of EUBA connections, but we are looking into this further.

TelstraClear should be able to provide its network footprint and overlay this to the Telecom exchange locations. If the exchange areas cannot be broken down between exchange lines and cabinetised lines in exchange locations, the figures can be aggregated to exchange coverage area.

If TelstraClear wholesales to other providers, this information should be included.

TelstraClear should outline any plans to change its network in the next 24 months.

If an Access Seeker uses upstream inputs **other than from Telecom (the Commission will be able to derive the UCLL coverage and UBA coverage from Chorus and Wholesale data – if Wholesale is allowed to give that data)**, the Commission should ask for details of the Telecom exchange location, or geographic description if this is not available.
