## **Commerce Commission Review of the Co-location Specified Services**

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Commerce Commission's *Review of Colocation on Cellular Mobile Transmission Sites, Draft decision on whether to commence an investigation under clause 1(3) of Schedule 3 of the Telecommunications Act, 23 September 2025* (the 2025 Mobile Co-location Review).

As the Commission is aware, the specified mobile co-location service has been an important regulation, including regulatory backstop to 2degrees commercial negotiations, over time.

2degrees agrees there have been a number of developments impacting this market since the Commission's last review, including that Spark, One NZ and 2degrees have sold tower assets to specialised asset management companies (TowerCos).

2degrees agrees that if co-location regulation is maintained, the Commission would likely need to investigate amendment of the service description of Mobile Co-location to ensure TowerCos, which now provide the majority of these services to the market, are captured. **[C-I-C**
