## NZBA APPLICATION FOR AUTHORISATION

## LIST OF PARTICIPANTS

- 1. The New Zealand Banking Association Te Rangapū Pēke ("NZBA") has previously submitted amendments to the list of participants ("Previous Notices")<sup>1</sup> in relation to its application to the Commerce Commission dated 11 September 2025 ("Application") for authorisation and interim authorisation under the Commerce Act 1986 regarding collective bargaining for cash-in-transit ("CIT") services in New Zealand ("Arrangement").
- 2. As outlined in the Previous Notices, all Participants retain the ability to withdraw from the Arrangement at any time and for any reason by notifying the NZBA.
- 3. On 15 December 2025, NZBA received notice that SBS has withdrawn from the Arrangement. Accordingly, effective from 15 December 2025, SBS is no longer a participant.
- 4. NZBA confirms that the following parties (subject to any further withdrawals under paragraph 5 below) comprise the group of "Participants" for the purposes of the Application:

    - (v) The Co-operative Bank;
    - (vi) TSB; and
    - (vii) Westpac;
  - (c) the following non-bank customers of CIT services in New Zealand:
    - (i) NCR Atleos New Zealand; and
    - (ii) Woolworths New Zealand.
- 5. For the avoidance of doubt, all Participants continue to retain the ability to withdraw from the Arrangement at any time and for any reason by notifying NZBA.
- 6. No new parties may join the Arrangement beyond those outlined in paragraph 4 above.
